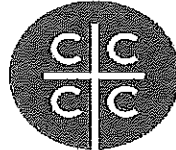

Come, with all Thine an-gels, come, Raise the glo-rious har-vest-home. A-men.




GO NOW IN PEACE

stead-fast, strong and true. Know He will guide you in all you




